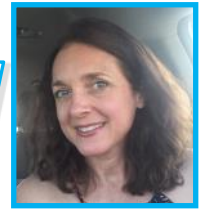

# NEWS: In-Person Worship

## We're gathering in worship again very soon!

While worshipping online is valid, most of us miss coming together in person for worship very much. It's been over a year. Our Healthy Church Team has decided that now that the weather is warm enough, we are planning to offer an outdoor worship experience at 11 AM on Sundays, beginning May 9. We will also be offering a Facebook live service at 9 AM. We have decided to begin with outdoor worship in order to start small, and it allows us limited singing. Please know that the requirements for United Methodist Churches in Virginia are a bit more restrictive than those of the CDC and Virginia Dept. of Health. **The Virginia Annual Conference Requirements** <https://doc.vaumc.org/Return/TAM.pdf> allow us to gather under these conditions.

- ◆ Each worshipper must fill out a Health Form prior to attending worship.
- ◆ Masks will be required.
- ◆ Six feet social distancing is required, except for those living in the same household.

We will gather in the circle outside the main sanctuary doors on the Wolfe Street side of the building. The service will be planned for 45 minutes. Please bring your own chair if you would like to sit. We will provide a few folding chairs for those who need them.

Our Healthy Church Team will meet to reevaluate the situation again on May 17.
